Minutes:

- 1) After brief discussion the group decided that the Developers Forum and the 1-way Paging Subcommittees were no longer active. The current active subcommittees are PWG, DSG and Industry Awareness.
- 2) Due to time constraints, Ron Mercer gave his presentation on several new ideas – ReFLEX repeater to support tracking & communications in underground mines; Text messaging for small private systems; and some 1-way telemetry opportunities. His presentations are on the PTC Website.
- 3) The committee members voted to handle the RXP codebook updates via email procedure to the PWG.
- 4) WARN Act Progress:
 - a. Pat Adams is still working to get a liaison with the two cellular protocol groups for the C-interface.
 - b. John de Boer held a DSG subcommittee meeting after the general PTC meeting and reviewed the latest specification document.
- 5) It was announced that the AAPC would take over the ReFLEX Address and SPID Assignment Administration from Motorola. This should be active on the AAPC web site by the end of May. No AAPC membership is required in order to get either ReFLEX Addresses or SPIDs.
- 6) New business:
 - a. The committee voted that the next PTC Face-to-Face meeting will be held in Scottsdale November 5th in conjunction with the EWA / AAPC Show.
